# Worshiping, Praying and Fasting Together as God's People

The early Christians at Antioch mentioned in Acts 13:1-3 demonstrated worshiping, praying and fasting. Pastor Sean gave us three ways these activities affect our relationship with God and with one another:

- 1. Worship God to teach one another.
- 2. Fast before God to strengthen one another.
- 3. Pray to God to encourage one another.

Sean encouraged us to focus on these three things as we prepare ourselves to celebrate Easter and as we trust in God's Spirit to grow and build our community here at FPC.

Pastor Sean often has more to share with us than he is able to fit in his sermon on Sundays. Each week he will be sharing "a few odds and couple ends" in the newsletter for our further understanding and contemplation.

# A Few Odds and A Couple of Ends from Acts 13:1-3

Church Father, Basil. Basil was one of the three 'Cappadocian Fathers,' along with Gregory of Nyssa and Gregory of Nazianzus. In the book that I quoted from, called On Fasting and Feasts, Basil also talks about the importance of feasting, or celebrating together as a Christian community. Basil knew that coming together as Christians and sharing meals with one another, especially after a period of communal fasting, is a wonderful way to fellowship together as God's people, celebrate Christ's resurrection, and appreciate God's good creation that was led to fast in a particular way during Lent this year, don't forget that breaking the fast in celebration is part of the process too, and is something to look forward to!
