

Our Circumstances Change but Our God Doesn't

This week Sean preached from Malachi 3:6, and showed how God is the only one who never changes. Because God never changes, we can trust Him in our changing circumstances (getting older, losing our health, losing our loved ones, losing a job, moving), and we can trust Him with our confession (God never changes from being gracious and is always accepting of repentant sinners).



Pastor Sean often has more to share with us than he is able to fit in his sermon. Here he shares "a few odds and couple ends" for our further understanding and contemplation.

The fancy terminology for the idea that God never changes is the doctrine of Divine "immutability." Many theologians today do not believe in divine immutability, instead advocating for either 'process theology' or 'open theism,' views which state that God, like us, goes through time, changes, and grows. But if this is true, can we really worship Him? Can we really trust Him? Is He perfect? It is true that God, being united to human nature in the person of Jesus Christ, grew, learned, and changed as we do, but God's divine essence is above all change and transcends decay change. Let's never forget that truth!

select one of those dates for you.


