## The Love of God Changes Everything

This week Sean preached a one-off sermon from John 3:16. In this passage we see how God gives His abundant love, how He gave His only Son, and how He will give eternal life. In response to all of these things, we must give Him our trust and love.

## A Few Odds and Couple of Ends

Pastor Sean often has more to share with us than he is able to fit in his sermon. Here he shares "a few odds and couple ends" for our further understanding and contemplation.

I mentioned how there is some debate about the word "begotten" in the King James Bible in this verse. Our NIV (and many other Bible translations) omit this word, I think to their detriment. The traditional view of Jesus' relationship to God the Father is called "Classical Trinitarianism," and on the basis of the word 'begotten' used here and elsewhere, states that God the Son was always the Son of God the Father. This is in contrast to a newer view called "Social Trinitarianism," which says that the three persons of God are better thought of as Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer, and only become Father, Son, and Holy Spirit as they relate to the world. But this is not the picture the Bible paints, which is that our God is a Trinity of persons whose relationships are best described by the words 'beget', 'begotten', and 'proceeds from', yet are the same in essence, nature, and substance (as the Nicene Creed lays out).
